Who We Are

The Greenhouse is the UK's first zero-waste performance space. Through the power of art and storytelling, we help people realise the impact they can have on the course of the climate crisis. We build and operate a beautiful, award-winning pop-up venue made entirely from found and recycled materials, where we offer our programme of shows and workshops. Through this, we help our audience build deeply personal connections with the climate crisis, while giving them the practical skills they need to convert interest to action.

What We Do

Our work falls in to three categories. Our artistic programme inspires, moving away from the traditional facts and figures, instead helping people connect with the crisis on a personal and emotional level. It converts the narrative from something terrifying and intangible to something they can see, feel, and ultimately, effect. Then, our education and outreach programme converts that inspiration to action. It gives our audience the practical skills and knowledge they need to make changes they care about at work and in everyday life. This provides a clear through line from theatre to education, so audiences have a direction for their newfound passion.

Business Support

Finally, we offer business support. Using our storytelling background and environmental experience, we help organisations of all shapes and sizes understand how storytelling can help sustainability in their business. From team-building sessions to consulting on sustainable corporate culture, and even private viewings of our shows with bespoke workshops, we offer a wide range of services that we can tailor to suit you. Previous partners have included the University of Edinburgh, Spectra Films, and the London School of Economics.

The Greenhouse will be constructed beneath a canopy of trees in Jubilee Park, Canary Wharf (just behind the main entrance to the tube station). This puts the venue right at the heart of the estate, easily accessible for passers-by, residents, and professionals working on the estate.
